The Institute for Global Economics has invited Mr. Guy Sorman, French professor and columnist, to speak at its Distinguished Lecture Forum. Against the backdrop of growing inequalities globally, Mr. Sorman will share his thoughts on the role of philanthropy in a society and pose a question on how philanthropy can complement and supplement the national welfare system, with special reference to that in the US, France and Korea. He will then talk about the implications for Korea.
