In the aftermath of the COVID-19 pandemic, the global economy is expected to undergo unprecedented shocks and structural changes, along with a severe impact on socioeconomic activities for the foreseeable future. Aside from the serious contraction of economic growth worldwide, the ongoing deglobalization and digitization trends are set to accelerate in the coming years, altering the way in which international business and finance operate.

Against this backdrop, the Conference is intended to discuss: (i) the impact of the COVID-19 on global economy and geopolitical dynamics, (ii) challenges and opportunities for the financial services industry, (iii) implications for asset management in the period of super-low interest rate and hyper uncertainty, (iv) emerging issues for public pension funds and sovereign wealth funds facing increasing calls for improving investment performance and promoting social responsibility, and, (v) government policies and business strategies in coping with the COVID-19 new normal.
