




IGE-SFG International Conference

The world is now at a crossroads. While the pandemic is still unfolding, the fast turnaround has been facilitated by unprecedented stimulus packages and historic vaccine development. Global recovery from the coronavirus pandemic is now set to unleash a wave of changing paradigms for government policy and corporate management strategy, leading to a more sustainable growth. The legacy of COVID-19 is also accelerating transition towards new industrial ecosystems and a global green revolution, solidifying the current trend of ESG-focused and stakeholder-centric approaches to the future of business, and at the same time, expanding the scope of digital and platform economies.
